



Passport Information

All participants of a Southeast International Mission trip must have or obtain a passport. Passport costs are not included in the trip cost. The Missions Ministry must receive 2 copies of your passport upon applying for a trip or as soon as you receive your new passport.

- Copy must include the picture/info page and the signature page above.
- Passport must be signed.
- Submit 2 passport copies to:

If you have a current passport, the expiration date on your passport MUST be 6 months beyond the return date of the trip. If it is not 6 months, you will need to renew your passport as soon as possible to participate on the trip.

Don't have a passport?

Please start this process as soon as possible. You will need to schedule an appointment at a post office that accepts passport applications. Some post offices have longer wait times than others, so check various locations.

Extra Photocopy of Passport

The Missions Ministry recommends that all international trip participants leave a photocopy of their passport at home and carry a photocopy on the trip in a separate place from their actual passport.
