



In order to make each mission trip a positive learning and worship experience, CrossRoads Missions asks that each participant agrees to abide by the following guidelines:

- Each participant will remain in a minimum group of four, and must ask a staff person before leaving areas defined by CrossRoads Missions Staff.
- The drinking of alcohol, the use of tobacco, and the use of illegal substances will not be tolerated at any time during the trip.
- Females will not enter into the males' sleeping quarters and males will not enter into the females' sleeping quarters unless give specific permission by CrossRoads Staff.
- Power tools will be used by permission from CrossRoads Staff and youth leaders.
- Clothing Expectations: Shorts must NOT be shorter than four inches above the knee. Soffe style, cheer or running shorts are not acceptable. We strongly encourage basketball shorts. Tank tops must have a 2 inch strap. Spaghetti strap, low cut tank tops and cut off T-shirts are not allowed. Tight fitting clothes are not permitted. If the participant's definition of appropriate
- or modest differs from that of CrossRoads Missions, the participant will be asked to change.
